

Dear Parents and Guardians,

I wanted to take the opportunity to provide you with an update on the Mountain View School District's policy regarding athletics. As you may be aware, this week, the Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association (PIAA) postponed the start of the fall sports season to begin on Monday, August 24. Several days later, Governor Tom Wolf recommended that no high athletics begin until January 1, 2021. The PIAA responded by stating that they would meet with the Governor and/or his representatives to discuss the fall sports season. This meeting will take place on Friday, August 21.

Once a decision is made regarding fall sports, additional information will be communicated to our coaches, student-athletes, and their families. Should the recommendation from the PIAA be that the fall sports season begin on or after August 24, the Mountain View Board of Education will move to hire coaches at the August 24th Board meeting.
