

## Mountain View Performing Arts Association Scholarships 2024

#### The Fargnoli Music Education Scholarship

This scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded to a senior student majoring in Music Education (Choral or Instrumental). Students must fill out a scholarship application and submit an essay to the MVPAA Officers. Topic of this essay will be "What music means to me." Students must also submit proof of acceptance into a Music Education program. This scholarship has been established in honor of long-time music educator Marilyn Fargnoli.

### The Break a Leg Scholarship

This scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded to a senior student majoring in Theater Direction/Production/Administration. Students must fill out a scholarship application and submit an essay to the MVPAA Officers. Topic of this essay will be "What theater means to me." Students must also submit proof of acceptance into a Theater Direction/Production/Administration program.

#### Talent for Life Awards

These awards are presented to members of the graduating class who plan to continue their performing arts experience at a higher education institution or in the military. Each award is \$300. Interested students must complete an application and provide proof of acceptance to a higher education institution or the military. Students must be enrolled in Band, Chorus or Drama during their senior year.

To be eligible for scholarships and awards, students must complete four hours of performing arts service at concerts/shows or the produce market during their senior year. Executive board will keep track of hours of service. Deadline for scholarship applications is April 1st. No extensions will be granted. Scholarship applications can be turned into Mrs. Bottger or Mr. Stiver.
