The LEA will require regardless of vaccination status isolation for 5 days for positive COVID-19 cases. If a student/employee has no symptoms or symptoms are resolving after 5 days, a student/employee may return back to school and it is recommended to wear a mask for an additional 5 days. However, if a student is home and symptomatic after the 10 days of isolation, a clearance from a primary care provider is strongly recommend for a return to school. If an employee or student is a close contact of a positive COVID-19 case, they should monitor themselves for COVID-19 symptoms. If they become symptomatic, they should test immediately. If not symptomatic, a close contact may attend school. In such a case, the district recommends wearing a mask indoors for 10 days. However, all close contacts should monitor their health for any symptoms for the full 14 days after
f. <u>Diagnostic</u> and screening testing;	exposure.  The district is open to the opportunity if offered by the PA Department of Health to conduct diagnostic and screening testing on school district campus for students and staff.

Efforts to provide <u>vaccinations to school</u> <u>communities;</u>	The district has offered two separate vaccination clinics to our faculty, staff, students and community in March 2021 and June 2021. One of the clinics were open to all community members 12 years and older. A clinic was held on December 21, 2021 for children and adults to receive their vaccination and booster shots along with flu shots.
